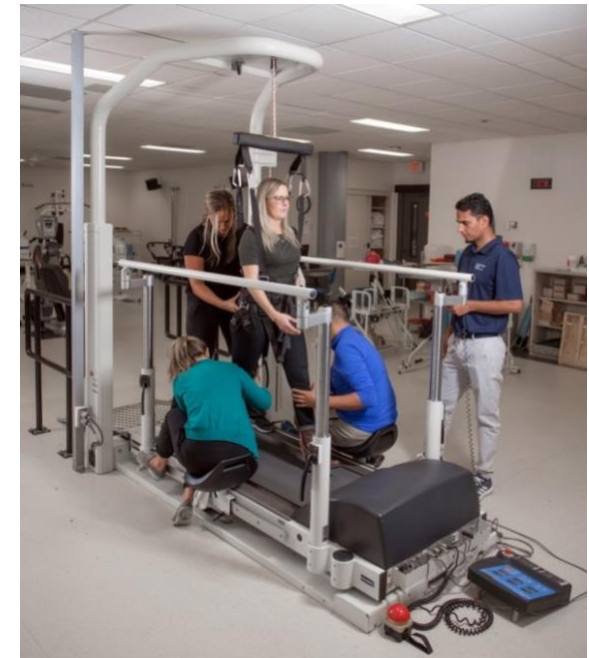
BrainEx 90 Group Program
